Non-infectious clinical waste is commonly known as offensive waste. Although not harmful to human health, non-infectious waste needs to be disposed of with care.

Non-infectious waste is waste contaminated with bodily fluids from patients with no known or suspected infection, such as swabs, dressings, nappies or incontinence wastes. Non-infectious waste bags are disposed of via deep landfill.

### Instructions for use:

Place non-infectious waste contaminated with bodily fluids from patients with no known or suspected infection in this tiger striped bag. Waste includes blood contaminated waste, swabs and wound dressings.
