## Label your healthcare type waste

**phs** Group

Important Information: Changes to ERP05-07 legislation for the labelling of healthcare type waste. To meet the requirements of ERP05-07 legislation around the labelling of healthcare type waste, **phs** are implementing a waste labelling initiative to ensure proper categorisation and disposal of this waste.

This legislation says that businesses must label their own healthcare type waste before collection, meaning **phs** can no longer pick up unlabelled waste.



## A reminder of what's changing?

The main change affecting your business, the producer, is the requirement to have a label displaying specific details (or a unique identifier) on the largest of the single container transferred. If you provide just a bag or rigid bin, there also needs to be a unique identifier on this.

## The label you place on your waste receptacle must include:

- Your businesses name
- Your business postcode
- **phs** as the collector
- Date waste was placed at waste collection point

STEP 2



Label your bin or bag waste

STEP 3



Place your waste ready for **phs** to collect

STEP 4



Receive confirmation of waste collection from **phs** 

## Key takeaway

If your container has a pre-affixed label on it, you must complete this. If your waste container doesn't have a pre-affixed label, we will provide you with one which should be completed and fixed to the container or bag prior to collection. This does not relate to offensive or sanitary waste.



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
